Japan Visa Document Checklist for Nepali Applicants

1. Valid Passport

- Requirement: Original passport with at least two blank pages and a validity of at least six months.
- Photocopies: Bio-data pages (first and last) and any previous Japanese visas.

2. Completed Visa Application Form

- Details: Accurately filled and signed application form.
- Photo: Recent passport-sized photograph (45mm x 35mm) attached.

3. Certificate of Eligibility (COE)

- **Purpose**: Required for long-term stays (e.g., work, study, dependent).
- **Issuance**: Obtained from the Japanese Immigration Bureau through your sponsor in Japan.

4. Cover Letter

- **Content**: State the purpose of your visit, duration of stay, and itinerary.
- Format: Typed and signed by the applicant.

5. Financial Documents

- Bank Statements: Original bank statements or passbooks for the last six months.
- Income Proof: Latest income tax returns or salary slips.

 - Leave approval letter.

- **Details**: Flight reservations and day-to-day itinerary in Japan.
- Note: Actual ticket purchase is not mandatory before visa approval.

- **Requirement**: Hotel bookings or invitation letter from a host in Japan.
- Host Documents: If staying with a host, provide their residence card and employment details.

- **Purpose**: If a guarantor in Japan is sponsoring your trip.
- **Details**: The guarantor's income proof and residence certificate.

 - Marriage certificate (for spouses).
 - o Birth certificate (for children).
- **Translation**: Documents not in English or Japanese must be translated.
